## 2011 EXHIBITION RUNS

1. No exhibition runs if over 100 shooters are pre-registered.
2. No exhibition runs at the Regional, July, or the State Shoots
3. Exhibition runs will be available Saturdays only.
4. Exhibition runs will only be available for the first three stages on Saturday only.
5. A maximum of 10 horses will be able to exhibition.
6. All runs are first come, first serve.
7. Cost per run is \$15
8. Riders have a maximum of 60 seconds in the arena once the course is engaged. If the horse has not engaged the course in 60 seconds, the rider must leave the arena.
9. A horse entered in the main match can not be exhibitioned, unless the following 2 exceptions apply:
  - a. If you are a new rider you may have an experienced competitor to ride your horse in an exhibition run (see match director if this occurs).
  - b. If you have never tried Cowboy Mounted Shooting. You may run one stage. The cost is \$20. Peach State will provide the horse and guns if necessary.
10. Except for the above, exhibition riders must be entered into the main match to exhibition, and may not ride their main match horse or any other horses entered into the main match.

## 2011 SAFETY RULES and GUIDELINES:

It is the responsibility of every individual present for their own safety and that of others. The match director must be informed of any potentially dangerous situations immediately.

1. All firearms shall be treated as if they are loaded
2. All loading of firearms should be done immediately before getting ready to run a stage.
3. Keep the muzzle of your guns pointing down when handling firearms.
4. No firearm shall be cocked until immediately prior to engaging a target.
5. Riders are responsible to make sure their firearms are loaded, check for missing or dented primers, cylinders rotate freely, and to be certain they are properly indexed prior to stage engagement.
6. Competitors are expected to compete safely within their individual capabilities at all times. Do not try to "over ride" your own horsemanship skills.
7. All contestants shall be knowledgeable and proficient in the safe use of firearms. If you are not comfortable with loading your firearm, please ask an experienced competitor to assist you.
8. All New Shooters please see Match Director at the loading table immediately following the safety meeting.
9. CMSA recommends the use of eye and ear protection at all CMSA sanctioned matches. Parents shall have eyes and ears protection available for wranglers when ground shooting.
10. Do not approach the Range Master while on duty. Any questions on a call should go directly to the match director with \$50 for appeal. An arbitration board has been chosen, and will inform you of their decision. Your \$50 will be refunded if the decision rules in your favor.
11. Parents or guardians of wranglers or their designate person may be in the arena when a wrangler competes. The wranglers should be able to ride the course on their own.
12. Deliberate gun twirling in an arena shall be a 5 second penalty.
13. Do not tie a horse to the red rail around the announcers booth at Chicopee Woods Agricultural Center.
14. Any horse abuse will result in disqualification
